The Ins and Outs of In-Kind Support and Maintenance (ISM)

(Old Age Pension and Aid to the Needy Disabled-Colorado Supplement only 9 CCR 2503-5 3.520.79 A through H)





Shelter costs less than \$270 and not paying fair share	 Owns and lives in their primary residence
Being charged an ISM by SSA	Receives subsidized housing
Has a Life Estate and shelter costs are provided in full	Homeless
 Educational Loan/Grant and all shelter costs are provided in full 	Paying fair share of market value or greater (even if less than \$270)
Paying no shelter costs and all shelter costs are provided in full	 Paying shelter in amount equal or greater than \$270

How to calculate an ISM:

If the client pays no shelter costs and shelter is provided, \$270 ISM is applied.

If the client pays less than their fair share, the amount they are paying is subtracted from the fair share amount or \$270, whichever is less. If the client's shelter costs are less than current market value, the amount the client is paying is subtracted from \$270.

The 2018 maximum ISM amount is \$270.

If the client receives SSI and is being charged an ISM by SSA the client will be charged a matching ISM.

Fair Market Value = the average market value of shelter costs.

Fair Share = the rent/utility costs of the household equally divided by the number of people who live in the home.
