

Project #14071 CBMS Expedited Food Improvements

This project is making enhancements to how an eligibility worker will see a client's Expedited Food Assistance on a case. This enhancement will reduce the number of clicks, and will enhance the ability to see important data regarding Expedited Food Assistance. With this project, reports that include Expedited Food Assistance information will be updated to ensure accuracy. This includes Pending Application reports as well as the County and ESC Dashboard in CBMS.



This project adds an indicator in the application header on any of the application screens after the case clearance has been completed.
