

Colorado Works Household Composition and Circumstances

A Colorado Works household consists of individuals who live together and must apply for Colorado Works as a single household (the Assistance Unit or AU) and individuals whose income must be used to determine financial eligibility for the household (the Budgetary Unit or BU). Members of the household may or may not be individually eligible to receive Colorado Works. This desk aid shows whether or not members of a household can receive a Colorado Works payment, will have their income counted when determining eligibility for the household, and whether their TANF clock will tick based on whether the member is part of the AU or BU and whether or not the member is eligible, ineligible/disqualified, or excluded.
